RESPECTIVE FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS AND PRINCIPAL IN RELATION TO ADMISSIONS

The Principal will manage the admissions procedure for this school in consultation with the Board of Governors.

When considering which children should be selected for admission, the Board of Governors will only take into account information which is detailed on the application or provided directly to the school. Parents/Guardians should therefore ensure that all information pertaining to their child and relevant to the school's admissions criteria is stated on the application or provided directly to the first preference school. Examples of such information include whether the child has brothers/sisters attending the school or is the eldest child in the family.

Please telephone the school if you would like to book an individual tour with the School Principal.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

During the admissions procedure when applying the criteria punctual applications will be considered before late applications are considered. The application procedure opens on 7 January 2026 at 12noon (GMT) and an application submitted by the closing date of 21 January 2026 at 12noon (GMT) will be treated as a punctual application. An application received after 12noon (GMT) on 21 January 2026 and up to 4 pm on 26 January 2026 will be treated as a late application, this is also the last date and time for processing a change of preference in exceptional circumstances. After 4 pm on 26 January 2026 no applications will be processed until after the close of procedure on 23 March 2026.

COMPULSORY SCHOOL AGE

Any child who reaches their 4th Birthday on or before 1st July 2026 is of Compulsory School Age. Under the School Age (NI) Act which became law in Northern Ireland in April 2022, 'compulsory school age' also includes those children who deferred commencing Primary 1 in September 2025 as defined by the new School Age (NI) Act (both groups to be treated equally).

Priority will be given to children resident in Northern Ireland at the time of their proposed admission to the school before those who are not so resident.

Admission criteria to be used in the event of the school being oversubscribed. The criteria are listed below in order of priority.

1. Children who have a sibling* or siblings* enrolled at Carrickfergus Model Primary School at the close of application.
2. Children whose sibling* previously attended Carrickfergus Model Primary School.
3. Children whose parent attended Carrickfergus Model Primary School. (Parents should include their full names at the times of attendance and the dates they were a pupil at the school).
4. Children who are a Looked After Child.
5. If oversubscribed, final selection will be made on the basis of a tie breaker established by admitting children from oldest to youngest by date of birth as entered on a birth certificate.
6. If still oversubscribed, children who live nearest to the school as decided by a straight-line digital measurement using the postcode address of their normal residence to the postcode address of

Carrickfergus Model Primary School. Carrickfergus Model Primary School will use the Northern Ireland portal for Geographical Information (GI) decision making tool, Spatial N.I., to determine distances.

*Where sibling is stated, it is taken to include half-brother / half-sister, step-brother / step-sister and foster-brother / foster-sister.

DUTY TO VERIFY

The Board of Governors reserves the right to require such supplementary evidence as it may determine necessary to support or verify any information on the application. The provision of false or incorrect information or the failure to provide information within the deadlines set by the school can result in the inability of the school to offer a place/the withdrawal of a place.

This is in addition to the **standard requirement to provide a Birth Certificate** in order to demonstrate whether or not a child is of compulsory school-age. Late applications will be dealt with in accordance with the relevant Department of Education Circular.

It is the responsibility of parents to ensure that all relevant information is provided to the Governors.

WAITING LIST POLICY

Should a vacancy arise after the 23 March 2026, all applications for admission to 2026-2027 that were initially refused, new applications, late applications and applications where new information has been provided, will be treated equally and published criteria applied. The waiting list will be in place until June 2027. The school will contact you in writing if your child gains a place in the school by this method. Upon receiving a completed application form (at any preference stage) your child's name will be automatically added to the list. Please contact the school if you wish your child's name to be removed from the list.

ADMISSION TO P2 – P7

The above criteria will also be used for application for P2-P7. Whilst oversubscribed in some year groups, requests for places in P2-P7 will only be considered if there are vacancies in the appropriate year group and further enrolment is not prejudiced to the efficient use of resources.
